### Theme

**Taste of Hiking Mont Blanc [Switzerland to France]** empowers you to experience a 3-day section of the mythical Tour du Mont Blanc so you can see what all the fuss is about.

**Taste of Hiking Mont Blanc [Switzerland to France]** brings Europe's most talked-about hike within easy reach of the healthy and relatively-fit hiker. You stay in Lac Champex or 'Little Canada' and the Col de Forclaz [Franco-Swiss frontier] and enjoy the 'Grand Balcon du Sud', one of the finest hiking trail in Europe. Your average an unhurried five-and-a-half hours a day, so can enjoy the alpine ambiance at your own pace.

**Taste of Hiking Mont Blanc [Switzerland to France]** comprises luggage transfers and four comfortable hotels with double rooms and en suite facilities. There is also the option to prolong your stay and experience one night in a carefully-selected mountain chalet-refuge, with hot showers, a restaurant and bunk beds arranged in alcoves of six to allow for greater privacy. It's worth it to appreciate one of the finest hiking locations anywhere in Europe - a sublime mid-mountain lakeside getaway.



## 4-night Itinerary<sup>1</sup>

**Day 1** **Lake Champex.** Arrive in Champex, Switzerland and hotel check-in. Enjoy the location affectionately known as 'Little Canada.'

**Day 2** **Champex to Col de la Forclaz**  
[10 miles/16 kms, + 664 ms, - 672 ms, approx. 5.30 hrs]  
The views down the Upper Rhone Valley from Bovine are a treat, and the descent to the Franco-Swiss border absorbing.

**Day 3** **Col de la Forclaz to Argentiere**  
[11 miles/18 kms, + 920 ms, - 1185 ms, approx. 6 hrs]  
The climb to the Col de Balme is breathtaking and the views as you descend into France are as exceptional as they are expansive.

**Day 4** **Argentiere to Les Praz de Chamonix via La Flegere**  
[7 miles/11 kms, + 1120 ms, - 505 ms, approx. 6 hrs]  
Two options for the climb up to Lac Blanc: the GRP and the 'Grand Balcon du Sud' or the gentler climb via the TMB proper assisted by the 'ladders'. Imagine you're the only one there before descending the rocky steps to La Flegere and the cable-car down to your celebratory meal.

**Day 5** **End of Tour.** Buffet breakfast and departure. Bon retour et à bientôt!

Such reviews are expensive and individual hotels are expected to pay. Many have not bothered and have chosen to remain starless out of choice. This does not mean that these hotels have suddenly become bad. However, knowing one's accommodation suppliers intimately is now important than ever!

## Access & Departure

Best access is via Geneva airport or the Paris-Geneva TGV. Then fast train from Geneva to Martigny and onward to Orsières (30 minutes) on the Saint-Bernard Express. Then take a short onward bus-ride or ten-minute taxi ride.

From Italy, explore train options from Milan to Orsières via Brig in Switzerland.
